Dr. Victor M. Ordoñez is currently a Senior Fellow at the Resource Systems Institute of the East-West Center, on leave from Bancom Development Corporation, where he is Vice-President, and from De La Salle University (DLSU), where he is Director of the Educational Management Center.
